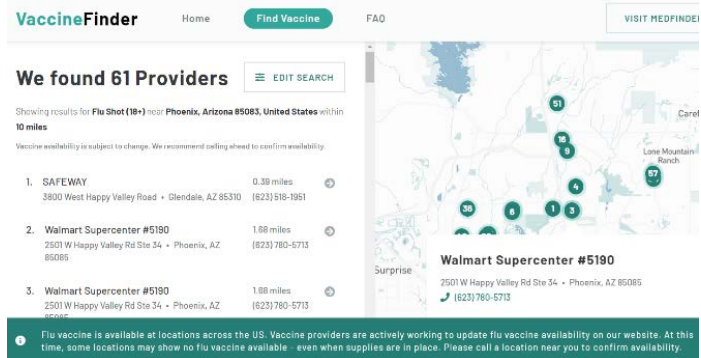
With the influenza season upon us, you can help your community access your flu vaccination clinics or events by registering for VaccineFinder.org. VaccineFinder's goal is to make it simple for people to find a nearby location to receive an influenza

vaccination. VaccineFinder allows you to post information about your vaccination services, whether for a curbside clinic or a mass vaccination event or for your general practice.
